Reason for establishment:

The trust was established in Ramadan 2000 (1421).

The main factor for the establishment of the trust was the existing intolerable suffering across the Muslim world, and none more so than in the aftermath of the conflict in Afghanistan. As a nation, Afghanistan, had by December 2001, lost more than 1.6 million lives. Furthermore approximately 1.8 million people had become victims of land mines, this represents the highest number of casualties in the whole of the Muslim world.

Conflicts similar to Afghanistan followed soon after, as seen in Iraq and we have seen the continuation of them in Chechnya and Palestine. To meet these crises the trust extended its activities to enable it to continue to serve the ever increasing needs of the Ummah.


Aims and objectives of Ummah Welfare Trust:

- To provide emergency relief to victims of natural disasters and conflicts.
- To provide clean water facilities in poor countries.
- To provide medical aid in the form of medicines, medical camps and artificial limbs to victims of disasters and casualties.
- To sponsor widows and orphans in a way which creates livelihood for them, thus enabling them to become self sufficient, e.g. sewing machines etc.
- To create educational institutions and orphanages.
- To create confidence in the suffering Ummah, that the rest of the Muslim Ummah, feel and care for their fellow Muslim brethren regardless of race, colour and origin.

The trust has been operating in the last three years in Afghanistan, Palestine, Iraq, Chechnya, India, Burma, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Albania, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Ethiopia, and Sudan.



Types of project works undertaken

- Carrying out emergency relief, food parcels and Ramadhan (iftari) projects.
- Providing clean water in poor drought stricken countries.
- Orphanage construction for 750 orphans of Afghanistan and Pakistan and to provide them with education of modern sciences and religious sciences.
- Providing basic amenities for widows/orphans and families in Iraq, Palestine,
 Kashmir, Afghanistan, Chechnya, Bangladesh.
- Sponsorship for orphans and families alike.
- Providing aid to Tsunami victims
- Rebuilding houses in Gaza.
- Providing prosthetic limbs to the victims of war in Chechnya.
- Providing aid in Iraq.
- Establishing Maktabs (religious educational classes) in Pakistan, Bangladesh, India and Chechnya.
- Providing basic amenities for poor students of Universities.
- Building Masajid in areas of need.

Chechnya

In the last decade a quarter of the Chechen population have lost their lives in this conflict. 60,000 innocent children have been killed through no fault of their own. Most of this beautiful land has been destroyed in acts of violence that would shock even the most hardhearted people. Today the people of Chechnya do not even enjoy the basic necessities that people take for granted, like water, electricity, medicines, food and shelter.

A staggering 1.6 million Muslims have lost their lives during the first war, 1979 - 1991. Nearly 2 million have become the victims of mines, maiming them forever in a totally unstable political and economic climate. The second war, 2001, has claimed the lives of a further 25,000 people and the toll continues.



Iraq

In Iraq over 100,000 thousand Muslims have been killed since 2003 50% of those were women and children. The previous 12 years of UN sanctions, took the lives of an estimated 1 million Iraqi children. Iraq was once the heart of civilisation and learning. Today Iraq does not even enjoy the basic living needs such as clean water, adequate sanitation facilities, sufficient electricity supply, medical supplies and equipment.

Palestine

In the land of the first Qibla, Palestine, within the period from September 2000 to May 2005, a total of 4075 Muslims have been killed, 2925 were men, 270 were women and 880 children. In addition to that, 3530 people have been permanently disabled. Also many homes have been demolished, many trees have been uprooted and much land has been confiscated.



UWT aims to protect and restore orphans basic rights as human beings. Ultimately to bring about a lasting enrichment of their situation, by means of improving access to reasonable basic humanitarian living, healthcare and education. We aim also, to provide opportunities for those children to develop their potential and to learn skills which will enable them to become self-sufficient, giving them a brighter future and paving the path for a peaceful society.

UWT will provide 700 – 1000 orphans from Afghanistan, Kashmir and Pakistan with shelter, daily food, medical treatments and education, both in Islamic and Modern sciences.
