ALBANIA

Orphan Sponsorship

343 orphans are being sponsored in and around Tirana. Twenty-five pounds is being paid to each orphan every month.



Teacher Sponsorship

A monthly salary is being paid to 7 scholars who are providing free Islamic education to children in poor communities.

Islamic Books

Free Islamic literature is being provided to 450 families, which will provide the necessary knowledge to children and adults about Islam.



Masjid Renovation

In the Masjid Renovation Project six Masjids will be renovated in five different districts of Albania, so the Muslim population can have the facility of Masjid and Quran Teaching.



Financial Assistance

This is a Financial Assistance project in which 1,440 beneficiaries will be supported with ALL 14,000 (Approx. £100) to help them meet their day to day needs.



Ramadan Iftar

Under this project Food packs including Oil, Rice, sugar, Drinks, Coffee, Makroni, sauces, beans, Dates and etc and Cash Assistance worth £50 in Local currency will be provided to the poor beneficiaries of Albania to help them in the blessed month of Ramadan.



Eid Gifts

Financial Assistance of £10 per child will be provided to the Muslim communities of Albania to understand the value of Eid and children can enjoy their Eid with a small cash gift.

BOSNIA

School Support

This project supports a free educational centre in Bosnia. They have as of March 2021 moved into new and bigger site, as classes and demand has grown. Nine staff are employed. The centre has 228 students, both adults and children, with each receiving free classes. It is the only Islamic school in Mostar.



Financial Assistance

This is regular programme providing financial assistance to the poor people in Bosnia. This is the first of this year with a second one planned later on and currently 32 beneficiaries benefit from this programme. Amount is determined as per their financial need.



BANGLADESH-ROHINGYA

Rohingya Fire Victims

Some 10,000 shelters/makeshift tents, most of which were destroyed when a recent fire broke out in the camps. Some 200 hundred families, approximately 1,000 beneficiaries, were given a one-off cash grant of 25,000 BDT, allowing them to purchase food, clothing and more.



Teachers Sponsorship

In this programme for 2021, 300 teachers will each receive a monthly stipend of 5000 BDT. These ulema are actively teaching the deen of Islam in the refugee camps in Cox's Bazaar.

GERMANY

Islamic Educational Centre

A free madrassah in Hannover, now in to its second year, is serving hundreds of local children. There was a great need to have an Islamic establishment to serve the local Muslim populations as the locals were greatly struggling with securing funding to establish the Islamic centre

INDIA

Masjid Construction

Three masjids are currently being built West Bengal. Once complete, each masjid will accommodate over 400 worshippers in shaa Allah.




Water Handpumps

In this project 5,111 water hand pumps will be installed in different villages of West Bengal and Assam which will approximately benefit 95,400 people living in different villages where there is no system of clean drinking water.



Water Wells

In this project 2 different kind of Water wells will be installed in Assam to provide clean water to the needy. The Ring wells (For hill Areas) and Mark 3 Water Hand pumps (for normal Areas) will benefit approx. 3000 people



Food Aid

Free food is being provided for Deoband's Waqf project. The institute caters for 2,700 poor students who are boarding. The free food will allow them to focus on studies and remain in good health.

Teacher Sponsorship

Just over 300 teachers in Gujarat and other parts of India are being supported with monthly financial sponsorship programme.



Hifz Sponsorship

1,080 students are enjoying a monthly sponsorship to assist them in completing the memorisation of the holy Quran.



Orphan Sponsorship

In Jammu Kashmir, 270 orphans are receiving monthly financial assistance to help them survive poverty.

Cataract Operations

Over 1470 beneficiaries are undergoing cataract operations. Surgery camps are being organised in different districts of West Bengal to ensure a greater coverage of poor patients.



Dialysis Treatment

Life-saving free dialysis treatments are being administered to sick individuals who are too poor to pay for the treatment.



Ummah Girls Academy

Construction of the new Ummah Girls Academy in West Bengal is still ongoing. Once complete it will for 200 poor and vulnerable girls from across the region. The girls will be boarding on a full-time basis and will receive a holistic education.



Widow Sponsorship

Monthly financial support is being given to 100 vulnerable widows in West Bengal. An allotted amount of £30 per month is help them meets their daily needs.



Medical Aid

This is an emergency Medical Assistance project in which the bills of poor and sick people are paid directly to the hospital. Patients who are unable to pay their bills or cannot continue their treatment are getting benefited from this project.

Financial Assistance for the Disabled

In this project, a total of 642 physically disabled people will receive £250 (approx.) which will help them meet their day to day needs



Ulama Financial Assistance

Under this project 2,385 teachers will be supported across Assam, Surat, UP, Haryana and other areas, in these regions the unaided institutions of rural areas are economically poor, their most pressing need is Financial Assistance so that they can fulfil their immediate needs of day to day use.



House Constructions

This is much needed and very successful Low-cost housing project in which a total of 114 houses will be built for poor Ulama. Every house will have a bedroom, drawing room, Toilet, kitchen, Veranda, shed and electrics.



Ramadan Iftar

Alhamdulillah, this Ramadan Ummah Welfare trust is implementing a Ramadan Iftar project all over India, cash and food bags have been distributed amongst poor Muslim families.



Sadaqatul Fitr

Under this project Ummah Welfare Trust will be distributing bags of rice and flour in different districts of India which will help over 18,000 families to cook their meals on the blessed day of Eid.

Eid Gifts

This is an Eid Gift Projects, especially for children, in this project just over 1,000 children will receive £10 cash in Local currency, this will help them enjoy their Eid and will put smile on their faces in this tough current situation

KASHMIR

Widows Sponsorship

A total of 136 widows are being helped with monthly financial support. They are receiving 18,000 PKR per month to assist them in their daily needs.



Orphan Sponsorship

270 orphans are being benefitted from a monthly sponsorship.

MACEDONIA

Teacher Sponsorship

13 teachers (6 Male and 7 Female) are being funded to teach free Islamic education to poor local communities.

Students Support

Three Macedonian students are being supported to continue their education in Azadville Johannesburg in South Africa which will help them focus on their studies and make change in the community

PAKISTAN

Cataract Surgeries

Over 1,389 poor rural patients from across Punjab are receiving free cataract operations. These life-saving surgeries will make a huge difference to these mostly farmers and labourers.



Masjid Construction

Seven large masjids and 37 small masjids have been newly constructed. A further 15 Masjids are currently under construction.



Wells Construction

In the latest round of construction, 439 medium and 300 deep wells have been installed so far. A further 94 small wells remain under construction across the Sindh region while another 250 deep wells remain under construction in Sindh and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.



Wells Maintenance

90 old water wells have been repaired in KPK, five in Punjab and over 100 in the Sindh province.

Medical Aid

Free health care has been provided to 1,580 needy patients in the districts of Swabi and Nowshera. A further 170 wheelchairs had been distributed amongst the mobility-impaired.

Housing Construction

Fifty-seven houses have so far been fully constructed out of total 66 houses. The remaining nine houses are currently being built for poor families in KPK.



Teachers Sponsorship

Over 471 teachers are currently being sponsored under this project. Each is receiving a monthly stipend of PKR 8,000.



Hifdh Sponsorship

1,600 Hifz students are receiving monthly support to complete the memorisation of the Holy Qur'an.



Orphan Sponsorship

A total of 1,300 orphans across the country are being sponsored. This regular assistance will make it easier for them as they grow up.

Widows Sponsorship

A total of 224 widows in Pakistan and 136 widows in Azad Kashmir are being helped with monthly financial assistance, so they can meet their day to day needs easily. Each Widow will receive £30 on monthly basis.



SPAIN

Islamic Educational Centre

A new madrassah in Seville is being subsidised by Ummah Welfare Trust. The centre provides free education and instructions to children up to the age of 15. The community here is expanding, so the centre is making a real difference.

SRI LANKA

Orphan Sponsorship

Monthly grants of £25 are being provided to 80 orphans across Sri Lanka

Teacher Sponsorship

Financial support is being provided to 50 teachers who are working across different Makhtab's in Sri Lanka.

Ramadan Iftar

Alhamdulillah, this year in this blessed month of Ramadan Ummah Welfare Trust will distribute £50 cash in local currency amongst 1,500 families

UNITED KINGDOM

Hardship Support

Individuals struggling financially due to the Covid 19 pandemic and increased redundancies are being helped, following assessments, with financial assistance.

Masjid Support

Small masjids struggling to cover bills and debts are being helped with financial grants.

HAITI

Medical Clinic Support

Each month hundreds of patients benefit from the use of this clinic. The Clinic has been operational since it reopened in July after a nationwide lockdown but with skeleton services.



IRAQ

Orphan Sponsorship

Monthly grants of £34 is given to each orphan. This project is still ongoing despite temporary lockdowns in some areas of Iraq. This grant supports the orphans with their basic day to day needs



Widow Support

Widows have suffered in Iraq for decades now and the situation is so critical now that many don't have enough money to meet their day to day expenses. UWT will be giving \$500 each to 1284 Widows in Anbar, Mosul, Baghdad and Erbil



Ramadan Food and Financial Assistance

Under this project, 223 families were given a £50 food pack consisting rice, flour, kidney beans, tea, milk powder, chickpeas, lentils, salt, dates, oil, tomato paste, and sugar. They were also given £50.00 cash in Local currency so the families can spend on other necessities during the blessed month of Ramadan.



Eid Gifts

As part of our Eid Gifts project, 2000 orphans will be given £10 each in local currency. Insha'Allah, this money will help them buy some toys or clothes for Eid and bring some happiness in their lives.

Sadaqatul Fitr

Many in Iraq cannot afford to feed themselves adequately due poverty. InshaAllah, Ummah Welfare Trust will be distributing bastmati rice to 1,995 families, so that they can enjoy a nice meal on the day of Eid.

PALESTINE

Orphan Sponsorship

Ummah Welfare Trust is still providing the monthly sponsorship support of £25 to 1,963 orphans in local currency. This payment allows these orphans to fulfil their basic day to day needs and also to continue with their education.



Widow Sponsorship

UWT have continued to provide a monthly sponsorship of £30 to 120 widows. This payment helps the hard-pressed widows with meeting some of the essential everyday expenses.



Hifdh Sponsorship

A monthly sponsorship support of £15 is given to each of the 867 hifdh students. These students come from poor families and without this support, most of them would not be able to continue with their Hifdh programme.



Teacher Sponsorship

A monthly stipend of £200 each is provided to 3 female teachers and £140 to 45 teachers. Alhamdulillah, these teachers are supporting hundreds of students with essential Islamic education



Water Distribution

UWT have established a regular water distribution project providing regular supply of water to 700 families. In addition to this, many schools, masjids and hospitals receive a bi-weekly supply of clean water for their day to day needs.



Food Vouchers

Due to severe poverty and food insecurity in the Gaza strip, Ummah Welfare Trust have started a programme to support 350 vulnerable families. Each family receives £35 on a monthly basis to buy essential food items.



Ramadan Food and Financial Assistance

As part of our Ramadhan project, 1,115 families were assisted with £100 cash in local currency so they can spend on food and other necessities during the blessed month of Ramadan. Some of these families received a food pack and cash equating to £100 in total.



Eid Gifts

As part of our Eid Gifts project, 2,030 orphans will be given £10 each in local currency. Insha'Allah, this money will help them buy clothes or toys for Eid and bring some happiness in their lives.

Sadaqatul Fitr

As part of our Sadaqatul Fitr project, Ummah Welfare Trust will be providing 6,430 families with 30kg of Wheat flour and 1 Kg of dates. This will bring some relief in their struggles for food and some happiness on the day of Eid.

SYRIA

Orphan Sponsorship

Ummah Welfare Trust continued to provide monthly sponsorship support of £40 to 3,250 orphans in and around Idlib. This money will provide food, clothing and education for these orphans.



Injured Families Support

A monthly support of \$50 is provided to 953 families helping them meet their basic needs.



School Support

Ummah Welfare Trust has continued to show its support in the education sector to preserve and enhance the Tarbiyyah of the future generations. Alhamdulillah, UWT is sponsoring and providing salaries for 904 teachers across 8 areas in the North of Syria. Their salaries will be provided for a whole year.



Baby Milk

The displacement in Syria of a large number of people has led to immense suffering for new mothers and new born babies. UWT has been providing Formula Milk for babies through local medical clinics and has decided to continue with this much needed programme this year as well.



Bread Bakery

30,250 beneficiaries from 5,500 Households/Families will benefit by receiving bread packs (800 grams each pack) every day for 3 months (except on Fridays).

Each HH under 5 people will receive 1 packet, and HH with 5 people or more will receive 2 packets a day.



Walima Feast

Newly-wed couples can now provide a walima feast to our brothers and sisters inside Syria for £300. A full sheep will be slaughtered, cooked and distributed with rice to needy families.



Ramadan Financial Assistance

As part of our Ramadhan project, 7,800 families were assisted with cash and food. Some were given £100 cash so they can spend on food and other necessities during the blessed month of Ramadan. Some families were given a food pack along with £50.00 cash to see them through Ramadan.



Eid Gifts

As part of our Eid Gifts project, 3,050 orphans will be given £10 each in local currency. Insha'Allah, this money will help them buy clothes or toys for Eid and bring some happiness in their lives.

Sadaqatul Fitr

As part of our Sadaqatul Fitr project, Ummah Welfare Trust will be providing 8,400 families with rice, dates, figs and raisins. This will bring some relief in their struggles for food and some happiness on the day of Eid.

TURKEY

Uyghur Refugees Financial Assistance

UWT has been financially supporting the vulnerable Uyghur refugees living in and around Istanbul, Turkey. Most of the Uyghurs are in great need and do not have a regular income so, Insha Allah we will helping a further 650 families with financial support


Islamic Books for Uyghurs

In this project, UWT will publish 8 books in the Uyghur language and distribute 1000 copies to Uyghur Muslims to improve their knowledge and practice of Islam and retain their Uyghur identity.

YEMEN

Emergency Food Aid

The ongoing conflict has resulted in one of the greatest manmade disasters in recent times creating severe food insecurity. In response UWT has delivered a food aid project benefiting 365 poor families living in San'a.



Financial Assistance:

The struggles of the people of Yemen is well documented in the media but this hasn't improved their situation with increased rates of poverty in all parts of Yemen. In response UWT will be providing 45 poor families with \$300.00 USD each to spend on food, medication and other daily essentials.



MALAWI

Ramadhan Iftar

Ramadhan food packs have been provided to 730 families in Katema and Namwera areas.



Masjid Construction

Construction of the six Masjids near Zomba have now been completed.




Water Wells

A further drilling of 90 Wells is underway in Malawi.



House Construction

Construction of 30 homes in the Katema District has now been completed. These houses will be given to widows, the elderly and poor farmers. Preparations have now been made for 30 homes to be built.



School Support

Over 65 Maktab's and nurseries are being fully subsidised to ensure that hundreds of children can learn for free. Teachers were also offered professional development training.



Medical Clinics

Rural clinics in Katema and Makenjera are providing health check-ups and medicines to thousands of mothers and children.



Teacher Sponsorship

Teachers at a large rural madrassah are being reimbursed to ensure hundreds of children can continue to study.

ETHIOPIA

Ramadhan Iftar

Ramadhan food packs and cash assistance have been provided to over 1,000 families in Ziway Dugda District and Silte Zone.



Water Well

This is a new water well project being piloted in Ethiopia. The wells were dug in the Silte District and Kuno Area with an aim to benefit approx 350 families. Great progress has been made in the first month.



Orphan Sponsorship

Monthly grants of £25 is given to 1,505 orphans. This grant supports the orphans with their basic day to day needs.



Teacher Sponsorship

Teachers of rural Madaaris are being reimbursed to ensure that hundreds of students can study for free.

House Construction

Construction of 6 houses is currently in progress. These will be given to vulnerable families in the regions.



Masjid Construction

Construction of one Masjid has commenced in Shashamane, Ethiopia.



MOZAMBIQUE

Masjid Construction

Construction on behalf of UWT's late field officer, Marhoom Basharat, is currently underway in Beira, Mozambique



GAMBIA

Daru Sunnah, Banjul

UWT continues to sponsor Daru Sunnah School for Quranic Memorisation. The school hosts 739 boys and girls, from which 133 are boarding. UWT sponsors the salaries for 38 teachers.



Kunting Islamic School, Kunting

Islamic primary education for 212 students, of which 50 are Tahfeez Students. UWT sponsors all costs for both the tahfiz and the primary education, this includes running costs, boarding meals and salaries of all 42 tahfiz teachers.



Gunjur Islamic School

UWT sponsor teacher's salaries for Gunjur Islamic School in the South Kombo region. Gunjur Islamic School currently host 379 students across 25 classes.



Masjid Construction

The construction of the new Masjid in the Town of Kembujeh has now been completed. Plans are underway for a further 20 Masaajid to be constructed in Gambia over the next 12 months.



Aqeeqah

This is a new project in Gambia. The opening month for Aqeeqah has been a success, alhamdulillah. We will be offering donors the opportunity to donate their Aqeeqah in The Gambia for just £85.



Walemah Feast

Newly-wed couples can now also provide a walemah feast to our brothers and sisters in The Gambia for £85 per feast. This includes the slaughter of a full lamb, cooked in oil, onions, vegetables and other ingredients.



Ramadhan Iftar

A mixture of Ramadhan food packs and cash assistance has been provided to 3,850 families across various districts in The Gambia. This year priority was given to most deserving families from the rural provinces.



Masjid and Madrasah Renovation

This is a new project started in April which will be a fund for reconstructing and renovating masjids and madrasahs.

Hygiene and Sanitation

This is also a new project part of our new WASH strategy in the Gambia. We will be looking to improve the quality of sanitation facilities, toilets, learning environments and Masjids.

SIERRA LEONE

Makeni Islamic Centre

Quran centre with 382 students, both across boarding and non-boarding with also Islamic primary education. UWT sponsors all costs including meals for boarders and the salaries of 21 teachers.



Ilmo Dhikr, Freetown

Islamic nursery and primary school for 110 students, boys and girls. The school is fully sponsored by UWT including the salaries of 27 teachers. Construction has also been completed for a new student block.



Ansarul Islam, Freetown

Islamic secondary education for 600 students with an additional 150 tahfiz students. UWT sponsors the salaries of 39 teachers.



Masjid Construction

Construction of 20 new Masjids have been completed in the last quarter. Preparation for construction of a further 80 masjids are now fully in full swing.



Water Wells

Surveys of 300 Water wells have been completed and construction have commenced for over 200 wells.



Teacher Sponsorship

Teacher sponsorship has been revised and now 765 teachers and 7 senior teachers/monitors shall be sponsored to deliver the Islamic education programme in the new Masjids that have been built in Sierra Leone. 21,853 Students will benefit from this programme.



Hardship Cases

This is a new project for 2021. WARDA will identify and process hardship case applications and deliver cash support accordingly. The intended amount will be \$500 (Approx £420) however the final figure will be given in accordance to the beneficiaries' circumstances.

Ramadhan Iftar

Ramadhan food packs and cash assistance have been provided to 3,240 families across various districts in Sierra Leone including, Freetown, Bo, Kenema, Makeni and more.
