The joys of Eid were brought to hundreds of thousands of families across Asia this year. The largest programme in the region took place in sanction-hit Afghanistan, where over 3,000 animals were sacrificed. The meat was distributed across the country's impoverished rural areas, as well as to the recent earthquake victims in Paktika.

The next most extensive programme was in India's West Bengal region where 2,500 animals were sacrificed. Thousands of poor and marginalised Muslims across the region were given Udhiyyah to enjoy, alhamdulillah.

Across the border, in Pakistan, over 600 cows and goats were sacrificed to feed thousands of poor students and Muslims across the KPK province. Alhamdulillah, a further one thousand families in the mountainous Kashmiri district of Bagh also received your Udhiyyah.

Finally, thousands of miles east in Bangladesh, hundreds of animals were sacrificed, and their meat distributed to poor families in the northern district of Thakurgaon.

Ummah Welfare Trust's largest programme in the Middle East was carried out in Yemen. Three thousand goats were sacrificed here, feeding tens of thousands of families across the capital Sana'a and in the besieged province of Ta'iz.

Further north in Bilaad ash-Shaam, 300 rams were sacrificed in Syria's Idlib province, while 55 animals were sacrificed in besieged Gaza. The meat of these animals brought smiles to thousands of families living under the devastating effects of war and isolation.

And in Iraq, Udhiyyah was provided to hundreds of orphaned and displaced families in the Anbari town of Ramadi, alhamdulillah.

Over 1,600 animals were sacrificed across the African continent this year. Qurbani took place in The Gambia, Malawi, Mozambique, Sierra Leone and Ethiopia, alhamdulillah.

The largest programme was in central Malawi, where 535 goats and 110 cows were sacrificed, feeding thousands of families in turn. In nearby Mozambique, 520 goats were sacrificed, providing meat to families in the shanty areas of the capital, Beira.

Alhamdulillah, to the north, 160 animals were sacrificed in Ethiopia and given out to orphaned and displaced families in the slum areas of Addis Ababa.

In West Africa, over 100 animals were sacrificed to feed poor Muslims in The Gambia. And a further 184 animals were sacrificed in Sierra Leone's inland areas.

Lastly, over 190 sheep were sacrificed in Albania, feeding hundreds of poor and orphaned families for the days of Eid, alhamdulillah.
