YOUR QURBANI IN ASIA

The joys of Eid were brought to hundreds of thousands of families across Asia this year. The largest programme in the region took place in sanction-hit Afghanistan, where over 2,500 animals were sacrificed. The meat was distributed to poor families in the capital, Kabul, and in the country's eastern regions.

The next most extensive programme was in India's West Bengal region where 2,000 animals were sacrificed. Thousands of poor and marginalized Muslims across the region were given Udhiyyah to enjoy, alhamdulillah.

Across the border, in Pakistan, over 650 cows and goats were sacrificed to feed thousands of poor Muslims in KPK and Sindh. Alhamdulillah, a further 425 animals were sacrificed for families in the Kashmiri districts of Bagh and Muzaffarabad.

In Bangladesh, over 100 cows were sacrificed, and their meat distributed to poor families in the southern district of Chattogram. Finally, in Sri Lanka, your cows fed 900 families across the island nation.

YOUR QURBANI IN THE MIDDLE EAST

Ummah Welfare Trust's largest programme in the Middle East came in Yemen. Around 1,600 goats were sacrificed here, feeding tens of thousands of families across the capital Sana'a and in the southern province of Ta'iz.

Further north in Bilad ash-Shaam, 200 rams were sacrificed in Syria's Idlib province, while 36 animals were sacrificed in Iraq's Anbar province. The meat of these animals brought smiles to over a thousand families enduring poverty and displacement.

YOUR QURBANI IN AFRICA & EUROPE

Over a thousand animals were sacrificed across the African continent this year. Qurbani programmes took place in Malawi, Mauritania, Sierra Leone and Ethiopia, alhamdulillah.

The largest programme was in central Malawi, where over 790 goats were sacrificed, feeding thousands of families in turn. To the north, around 170 animals were sacrificed in Ethiopia and distributed to orphaned and displaced families to the south of the capital, Addis Ababa.

In the west of the continent, over 20 animals were sacrificed to feed poor Muslims in Mauritania. And a further 20 cows were sacrificed in Sierra Leone's inland areas.

Lastly, over 110 sheep were sacrificed in Albania, feeding hundreds of poor and orphaned families for the days of Eid, alhamdulillah.
